THE HOUSING LAW, 1955.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 7.

Notice is hereby given that the following immovable properties are required by me for a housing scheme :—

All that area of privately owned land situated in the village of Beyuk Kaimakli, in the District of Nicosia, comprising 35 donums and 700 sq. ft. or thereabouts, being plots 226, 228, 230, 231, 237, 268, 240, 233, 234, 238 and 239 of Block C, Beyuk Kaimakli, more particularly defined as the area edged red (excluding the area coloured green) on the Government Survey Plan marked GREATER NICOSIA (KAIMAKLI) HOUSING SCHEME dated 18th March, 1957, and signed by the Director of Planning and Housing.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said immovable properties who objects to the acquisition is required within six weeks from the date of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. I am willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.

4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at the office of the Commissioner, Nicosia and Kyrenia.

THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION LAW.

CAP. 165 AND LAWS 10 OF 1950, 44 OF 1954 AND 18 OF 1955.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 17 (7).

With reference to the notice published under No. 864 in the *Gazette* of 2nd August, 1956, it is hereby notified for general information that after considering the plans and specifications concerning all the streets set out in the Schedule to the aforementioned notice and objections made, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to approve only the plans and specifications concerning the streets enumerated under column (1) to the extent shown under column (2) of the Schedule hereto.

2. The plans and specifications in respect of the streets set out in the Schedule hereto shall, subject to the conditions shown under column (2) of the Schedule, be binding on the Municipal Council of Nicosia and upon all owners affected.
