**THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by virtue of the Orders, a list of which appears in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the Orders") His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use for military purposes of the lands and properties set out in the Second Schedule to the Orders (hereinafter referred to as "the lands"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months ;

And whereas the Orders were subsequently extended, on the dates appearing in the Third Column of the Schedule hereto, for a period of six months from the expiration thereof ;
