THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)  
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 3) 1957.

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ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 38A.

In exercise of the powers vested in me under paragraph 3 of Regulation 38A of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1957, I, Robert Chattan Ross-Clunis, Commissioner of Limassol, do hereby suspend the operation of the Danger Areas (Limassol District No. 1) Order, 1956, published under Notification No. 1183 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 29th November, 1956.

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THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955.

LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

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ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Limassol District No. 14) Order, 1957.

2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Limassol or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 12th day of July, 1957.

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FIRST SCHEDULE.

Within the village boundaries of Prastio (Evdhimou).

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SECOND SCHEDULE.

From 04.00 hours on Friday the 12th July, 1957, until 12.00 hours of the same date.
