THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION LAW.

CAP. 165 AND LAWS 10 OF 1950, 44 OF 1954, 18 OF 1955 AND 12 OF 1957.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 17 (7).

With reference to the notice published under No. 235 in the *Gazette* of 23rd February, 1956, it is hereby notified for general information that, after considering the plans and specifications concerning all the streets set out in the Schedule to the aforementioned notice and objections made, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to approve only the plans and specifications concerning the streets enumerated under column (1) to the extent shown under column (2) of the Schedule hereto.

2. The plans and specifications in respect of the streets set out in the Schedule hereto shall, subject to the conditions shown under column (2) of the Schedule, be binding on the Municipal Council of Nicosia and upon all owners affected.
