**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)  
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 4) 1957.**

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

Whereas it appears to me to be expedient in the interest of public order and safety to take possession of the land described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land") and to authorize its use in the interest of public order and safety :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 4) 1957, which I have been authorized to exercise under Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th November, 1955, I, the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia, hereby take possession of the land and, in connection with the taking possession and making use of the land, I hereby direct and order as follows :—

- (1) The use of the land for the requirements of the Police is hereby authorized.
- (2) The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are hereby authorized to do, in relation to the land, anything which any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of that interest.
- (3) The exercise of any right of way over the land, and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited.
