THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 4) 1957.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 38 (1).

I, the Commissioner of Nicosia, in exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (1) of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 4) 1957, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Protected Areas (Nicosia District No. 4) Order, 1957.

2. The area specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a protected area for the purpose of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 4) 1957.

3. This Order shall come into force at 05.00 hours on the 22nd September, 1957, and shall remain in force until 12.00 hours on the same day unless revoked or extended by a supplementary order under my hand.
