THE EXCHANGE CONTROL LAWS, 1952 AND 1954.

ORDER MADE BY THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY UNDER SECTION 2 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 2 (1) of the Exchange Control Laws, 1952 and 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the Laws"), I, the Financial Secretary, hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Exchange Control (Authorised Depositories) Order, 1957.

2. The persons specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby authorised to act as authorised depositaries for the purposes of Part III of the Laws.

3. The Exchange Control (Authorised Depositories) Order, 1954, is hereby revoked. **Gazette:

4. This Order shall be deemed to have been made and to have come into force on the 1st day of November, 1957.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.
