

No. 998. THE SECONDARY EDUCATION LAW.

CAP. 205 AND LAWS 5 OF 1950, 18 OF 1952 AND 20 OF 1954.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTIONS 33 AND 34 (1) (m).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 33 and 34 (1) (m) of the Secondary Education Law, His Excellency the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Secondary Education (Amendment) Regulations, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Secondary Education Regulations.

2. The Tenth Appendix to the principal Regulations is hereby amended—

(i) by the revocation of paragraph 1 thereof and the substitution therefor of the following new paragraph to be numbered 1 :—
