THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION LAW.

CAP. 165 AND LAWS 10 OF 1950, 44 OF 1954 AND 18 OF 1955.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 14 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 14 (1) of the Streets and Buildings Regulation Law, the Municipal Council of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta, as the appropriate authority of that Corporation under section 3 (2) (a) of the aforesaid Law, do hereby, with the approval of the Governor, define the areas within the Municipal limits of the said Corporation, described in the First Schedule hereto, as zones within which only buildings for the special trades and industries specified in the Second Schedule hereto may be erected.

The notice published under No. 300 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 16th July, 1952, is hereby revoked in so far as the areas specified in the First Schedule hereto are concerned.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Part I.

All that area of land within the Municipal limits of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta comprising plots Nos. 93, 94, 99, and 100 and part of plots Nos. 65, 92, 97, 98, 101, 106, 156, 175, 478, and 661, Block "C", Ayios Loucas Quarter, which is shown edged purple on the plans of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta, numbered I.Z.2, signed by the Mayor of Famagusta and deposited in his office and open to inspection during office hours.

Part II.

All that area of land within the Municipal limits of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta comprising part of plots Nos. 31, 45 and 53, Block "C", Kato Varosha Quarter and part of plot No. 35, Block "G", Ayia Zoni Quarter, which is shown edged purple on the plans of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta numbered I.Z.3, signed by the Acting Mayor of Famagusta and deposited in his office and open to inspection during office hours.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

1. The warehousing of any kind of goods.
2. Any trade or business in which articles are manufactured, altered, cleaned, washed, repaired, ornamented, finished, packed, canned, adapted for sale, broken up or demolished or in which materials are transformed, including ship-building and the generation, transformation of electricity and motive power of any kind which, by reason of any process, carried on, machinery installed, traffic, noise, vibration, smell, fume, smoke, soot, ash, dust or grit made, caused or produced is detrimental to the amenities of any area other than an industrial area.
