

No. 24. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.
CAP. 233 AND LAWS 26 OF 1952 AND 22 OF 1956.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

Whereas it has been represented to the Acting Governor that it is desirable in the public interest for Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom to establish, use and maintain a station for wireless telegraphy in the vicinity of Zyvi, within the District of Larnaca, and to instal, use and maintain apparatus for wireless telegraphy in connection therewith, the cost whereof is to be borne by Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom.

2. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to declare the establishment, use and maintenance of the aforesaid station for wireless telegraphy to be an undertaking of public utility and has been pleased to authorise the carrying out of the said undertaking and has further been pleased to entrust the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to Mr. Percy George Crosby Farrell, M.B.E., the Assistant Director, Lands, Cyprus, or in his absence to the person acting for the time being as Assistant Director, Lands, Cyprus.

THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION LAW.
CAP. 165 AND LAWS 10 OF 1950, 44 OF 1954, 18 OF 1955 AND 12 OF 1957.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 17 (7).

With reference to the notice published under No. 311 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 19th May, 1955, as amended by notice No. 1013 published in the *Gazette* of 6th September, 1956, it is hereby notified for general information that, after considering the plans and specifications concerning the streets enumerated under column (1) of the Schedule hereto and objections made, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to approve the plans and specifications concerning the said streets to the extent shown under column (2) of the Schedule hereto.

2. The plans and specifications in respect of the streets set out in the Schedule hereto shall, subject to the condition shown under column (2) of the Schedule, be binding on the Municipal Council of Nicosia and upon all owners affected.
