

No. 74.**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 5) 1957.**

I, the Commissioner of Famagusta, in exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (1) of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 5) 1957, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Protected Areas (Famagusta District No. 3) Order, 1958.
2. The area specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a protected area for the purpose of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 5) 1957.
3. This Order shall come into force at 12.00 hours on Wednesday, 22nd January, 1958, and shall remain in force until 18.00 hours on Wednesday, 22nd January, 1958, unless revoked or extended by a supplementary order made under my hand.

SCHEDULE.

The main Famagusta-Larnaca road between 4 mile point and Akhyritou junction.

No. 75.**THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.
CAP. 233 AND LAWS 26 OF 1952 AND 22 OF 1956.****NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.**

With reference to Notification No. 24 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 16th January, 1958, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein :—

1. All that area of privately-owned land with everything standing thereon comprising 76 donums or thereabouts in the "Lakkia" locality of Tokhni and Zyyi villages, on the Government Survey Plan, Sheet LV plan 37, and more particularly defined as the area edged in pink and marked "A" on the plan signed by the Assistant Director, Lands, Cyprus and dated the 20th January, 1958.
2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands, who objects to the acquisition, is required within ten days from the date of the publication of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.
3. The Government is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said land.
4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at my office.
5. The period mentioned in paragraph 2 hereof has been abridged to ten days with the approval of His Excellency the Governor.
