SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

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No. 199. THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL, 1939 AND 1956.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Amendment of the Assemblies, Meetings and Processions Law) Regulations, 1958.
2. During the continuance in force of these Regulations, section 8 of the Assemblies, Meetings and Processions Law shall be read and construed as if for the full stop at the end thereof a colon were substituted and as if the following proviso were added at the end thereof :—

“Provided that the Governor may exempt from the provisions of any such Proclamation any assembly or class of assembly held under the authority of a written permit issued by the Commissioner and in accordance with such terms and conditions, if any, as the Commissioner may deem fit to impose in such permit.”
