THE CUSTOMS MANAGEMENT LAWS, 1954 TO 1957.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 232.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 232 of the Customs Management Laws, 1954 to 1957, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs Drawback (Amendment) Regulations, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Customs Drawback Regulations, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Customs Drawback Regulations, 1956 to 1958.

2. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended :

(a) by deleting the full stop at the end of the second proviso thereto and by substituting therefor a colon ;

(b) by inserting after the aforesaid second proviso the following further proviso :—

" Provided further that in respect of the goods specified at Item 3 of Part A of the First Schedule, drawback shall not be payable unless such goods are exported or put on board any aircraft or ship for use as stores."
