CAP. 64.

APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSIONER OF INQUIRY UNDER SECTIONS 2 AND 3.

Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2 and 3 of the Commissions of Inquiry Law, I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows:— Cap. 64.

1. This Order may be cited as the Commissions of Inquiry (Geunyeli Incidents) Order, 1958.

2. I hereby appoint a Commission of Inquiry consisting of Paget John Bourke, Kt., Chief Justice.

3. The terms of reference to the Commission shall be :—

To investigate and determine the facts concerning the incidents which occurred at and near the village of Geunyeli on Thursday, 12th June, 1958, in the course of which certain persons lost their lives and others were injured.

4. The Commission shall have all the powers set out in section 7 of the Commissions of Inquiry Law.

5. The Commission shall report to the Governor as soon as it completes its deliberations.
