SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

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THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 1) 1958.

ORDER UNDER REGULATION 41 (1).

Whereas I am satisfied that the publication at this time in the Colony of any of the proceedings taking place before the Commission of Inquiry into the incidents at and near the village of Geunyeli on Thursday, 12th June, 1958, would be prejudicial to public safety ;

Now therefore in exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 41 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 1) 1958, I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows :

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Prohibition of Publication : Geunyeli Inquiry) Order, 1958.

2. No person shall publish in the Colony any report of the proceedings taking place before the Commission of Inquiry appointed under the Commissions of Inquiry (Geunyeli Incidents) Order, 1958.
