ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 3025

MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (2).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 (2) of the Forest Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Minor State Forests (Nicosia, Kyrenia and Paphos) (Amendment) Order, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Minor State Forests (Nicosia, Kyrenia and Paphos) Order, 1942 to 1950 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and this Order may together be cited as the Minor State Forests (Nicosia, Kyrenia and Paphos) Orders, 1942 to 1958.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto, immediately after the area No. 40 (relating to the village of Syrianokhori), of the following area :—

"41. *Lefka in the District of Nicosia* : The whole area of the Crown land under plots Nos. 388, 389 and 81 of Block J., Lefka, demarcated by the boundary stones numbered consecutively from 1 to 20, inclusive, comprising 281 donums and 2,200 square feet or thereabouts and shown on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1705, delineated thereon in green".
