**No. 664. THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL, 1939 AND 1956.**

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Secondary Schools) Regulations, 1958. Short title.

2.—(1) In these Regulations unless a contrary intention appears :— Interpretation.

“ child ” means a person under the age of 21 years ;

“ headmaster ” includes any person performing the duties of headmaster during the absence of the headmaster from a school ;

“ secondary school ” means any school or other educational establishment, wherein pupils over the age of twelve years are taught, and includes the English School established under the English School (Management and Control) Law :

Provided that a school prescribed by the Governor under the provision of the Elementary Education Law, or any law amending or substituted for the same, shall not be deemed to be a secondary school by reason solely of the enrolment therein and the attendance thereof of pupils over the age of twelve years.

(2) The Interpretation Law shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations, and of any direction given thereunder, as it applies to the interpretation of a Law and, for the purposes of the said Law, these Regulations shall be deemed to be Laws.
