4. Paragraph (7) of Regulation 65 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the words "provisions of" which occur in the first line of sub-paragraph (a) thereof the words "an Order made under".

5. Any public instrument, direction or authorisation made under any Regulation amended, substituted or revoked by these Regulations in force immediately before the date of the coming into operation of these Regulations shall, notwithstanding any change in the authority by which such public instrument, direction or authorisation may be made, be deemed to have been made under the corresponding provisions of the principal Regulations as amended by these Regulations by each such authority so as to have the same effect throughout the Colony as if these Regulations had not been made and shall remain in force until the same shall be varied or revoked in accordance with the provisions of the principal Regulations as amended by these Regulations.

**No. 781. THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL,
1939 AND 1956.**

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) (Amendment No. 5) Regulations, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 4) 1958, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 5) 1958.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after Regulation 38, of the following new Regulation:—

"Danger areas. 38A.—(1) The Governor, if he considers it necessary or expedient in the public interest so to do, may, by Order to be published in the *Gazette*, declare any area within the Colony to be a danger area.

(2) The limits and extent of every danger area shall be demarcated at the site by such means as will, in the opinion of the Governor, make apparent to persons in or about the area concerned that such area has been declared a danger area.

(3) No person shall enter or remain in a danger area, and any person who fails to comply with the provisions of this paragraph shall be guilty of an offence against these Regulations:

Provided that the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to members of Her Majesty's Forces and of the Cyprus Police Force in the performance of their duty or to any person accompanied by such member:
