

No. 1143. THE GRAIN CONTROL LAW, 1953.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GRAIN COMMISSION UNDER SECTIONS 5 AND 20.

In exercise of the powers vested in it by sections 5 and 20 of the Grain Control Law, 1953, the Commission hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Grain Control (Milling and Bakeries) (Amendment) Regulations, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Grain Control (Milling and Bakeries) Regulations, 1954 and 1955, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Grain Control (Milling and Bakeries) Regulations, 1954 to 1958.

2. Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations is hereby deleted.

3. Schedule 3 to the principal Regulations is hereby deleted and the following Schedule substituted therefor :—

" SCHEDULE 3.—(Regulation 13.)

Bread sold or purchased in any town.	Bread sold or purchased in any village.
(a) forty (40) mils for each loaf of one kilogram.	(a) forty-three (43) mils for each loaf of one kilogram.
(b) twenty (20) mils for each loaf of one-half kilogram.	(b) twenty-two (22) mils for each loaf of one-half kilogram."

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 29th day of December, 1958.

The above Regulations have been approved by His Excellency the Governor.
