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No. 1. THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAW.

(CAP. 216 AND LAWS 14 OF 1951, 22 OF 1952, 1 OF 1954 AND 67 OF 1955.)

RULES MADE UNDER SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION 34.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sub-section (1) of section 34 of the Workmen's Compensation Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following rules.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Workmen's Compensation (Amendment) Rules, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Workmen's Compensation Rules (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules").
2. Rule 3 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by deleting the words "Commissioner of Labour" which occur in the second line thereof and substituting therefor the words "officer of the Labour Department in charge of the area in which the employer has his place of business."
