AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL LICENCE No. 19999.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of the Defence (Importation of Goods) Regulations, 1956, I, the Director of Commerce and Industry, do hereby declare that Open General Import Licence No. 19999 is hereby amended by substituting for sub-items (vii) and (xi) of item 34 thereof the following sub-items :—
