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No. 138. THE ASSEMBLIES AND PROCESSIONS LAW.
(LAW 7 OF 1958.)

ORDER MADE UNDER PARAGRAPH (b) OF SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION 5 AND
UNDER SUB-SECTION (2) OF SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section 5 and by sub-section (2) of section 9 of the Assemblies and Processions Law, 1958, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Assemblies and Processions (Exemptions) Order, 1959.

2. In this Order “the Law” means the Assemblies and Processions Law, 1958. 7 of 1958.

3. All classes of assemblies and processions in any public place are hereby exempted from the operation of section 4 of the Law :

Provided that this exemption is subject to the condition that any such assembly or procession shall conduct itself in accordance with the interests of good order and public safety and if such assembly or procession contravenes this condition it may be ordered to disperse by a Commissioner or an authorised officer in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Law as an assembly or procession for which no permit has been issued under section 4.

4. The Assemblies and Processions (Emergency Provisions) Order, P.I.: 435/1958, 1958, is hereby revoked.
