

(hereinafter referred to as "the Lender") the sum of two thousand two hundred pounds (£2,200) at a rate of interest not exceeding five and a half per centum ($5\frac{1}{2}\%$) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say :—

- (a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Municipal Corporation to the Lender in twenty equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest), the first instalment being payable one year after the date of borrowing and all subsequent instalments being payable on the corresponding date of each year following until final repayment ;
- (b) the Municipal Corporation shall, in each year and until final repayment of the sum borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on its revenues the annual sum payable as aforesaid in the year to which such estimates relate ;
- (c) the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Municipal Corporation for fencing the Municipal Refuse Depot.

2. For the purpose of securing the repayment of the sum under the loan, the Municipal Corporation is hereby authorized, subject to any prior mortgage thereon, to mortgage to the Lender all the rates, fees and duties now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Municipal Corporation.

**THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 9th November, 1956 and published under Public Instrument No. 1115 of 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), His Excellency the Governor has authorized the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated at Orta Keuy village (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months ;

And whereas by virtue of Public Instruments Nos. 499 of 1957, 965 of 1957, 302 of 1958 and 884 of 1958, the Order was extended for further periods of six months up to the 8th May, 1959 ;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1958), His Excellency the Governor has authorized the use of the said land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order for a further period of six months as from the 9th May, 1959.
