("PAPANICOLAS" WATER).DISSOLUTION OF THE IRRIGATION ASSOCIATION OF KLIROU
("PAPANICOLAS" WATER).

Whereas an application was made to the Commissioner of Nicosia signed by not less than two-thirds of the proprietors requesting that the Irrigation Association of Klirou ("Papanicolas" Water) (hereinafter referred to as the "Association") be dissolved ;

And whereas at a meeting of the proprietors of the Association held under Rule 18 of the Irrigation Association of Klirou ("Papanicolas" Water) Rules, 1950 (hereinafter referred to as the "Rules") at the village of Klirou on the 12th April, 1959, it was decided by the requisite majority of the voters present thereat that the said Association should be dissolved :

Now, therefore, it is hereby notified that the Association has been dissolved accordingly as from the 12th April, 1959, subject to the exception contained in the Rules.

THE IRRIGATION DIVISIONS (VILLAGES) LAW.

CAP. 111.

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, Cap. 111, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Agridhia "Kato Enetikon" in the District of Limassol, are published in the *Gazette*.

IRRIGATION DIVISION OF AGRIDHIA "KATO ENETIKON".

Rules.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Agridhia "Kato Enetikon" (Limassol District) Rules, 1959.

2. In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires—

"Commissioner" means the Commissioner of the District of Limassol.

"Committee" means the Committee of the Irrigation Division.

"Irrigation Division" means the Irrigation Division of Agridhia "Kato Enetikon", Limassol.

"Law" means the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, Cap. 111.

"List" means the list of the names and residences of the proprietors and of the lands and extent thereof which are to be benefited or are capable of being benefited by the works prepared under the provisions of section 15 of the Law as finally settled under the provisions of section 16 of the Law.

"Works" means the irrigation works of the Irrigation Division.

3. The Committee shall hold office for a period of three years beginning on the 28th January, 1957. Thereafter the election of the Committee shall take place every third year in the first week of the month of January, and it shall hold office for a period of three years from the day next following its election.

4.—(1) The Committee shall appoint a treasurer who shall collect the rates and charges assessed upon the proprietors mentioned in the list.

(2) The treasurer shall, on the 1st July, in every year, prepare a statement of all rates or charges still due and unpaid on that date and shall forward such statement to the Commissioner.

(3) The treasurer shall be unpaid; provided that he shall be paid such of his out of pocket expenses as may be sanctioned by the Committee.

(4) The treasurer shall be appointed for such period as the Committee may fix but in no case extending over the term of office of the Committee appointing such treasurer.
