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**THE ELECTIONS (PRESIDENT AND VICE-PRESIDENT
OF THE REPUBLIC) LAW, 1959.**

PROCLAMATION UNDER SECTION 7 (1).

HUGH FOOT,
Governor.

Whereas by sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Elections (President and Vice-President of the Republic) Law, 1959 (hereinafter referred to as "the Law"), it is provided that the Governor shall, after the coming into operation of the Law, by proclamation published in the *Gazette*, appoint a date for the election of the President and the same date for the election of the Vice-President, which shall be the date on which nominations of candidates shall be received :

And whereas I think it expedient that the third day of December, 1959, should be appointed as the date for the election of the President and of the Vice-President :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the said sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Law, I, the Governor, do, by this Proclamation, appoint the third day of December, 1959, as the date for the election of the President, and further appoint the said date as the date for the election of the Vice-President.
