THE EMERGENCY (RESIDUAL POWERS) LAW, 1959.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION 3.

39 of 1959 In exercise of the powers vested in me by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Emergency (Residual Powers) Law, 1959, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency (Residual Powers) Order, 1959.

2. In this Order—

“the Proclamation” means a Proclamation directing that the provisions of Part II of the Emergency Powers Order in Council, 1939 (which were brought into operation in the Colony by a Proclamation dated the 26th day of November, 1955) should cease to have effect.

3. The Emergency Regulations set out in the Schedule to this Order shall continue to have effect after the Proclamation by virtue of the Emergency (Residual Powers) Law, 1959.
