No. 193. THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAW.

CAP. 252 AND LAWS 11 OF 1950, 31 OF 1951, 20 OF 1953,
29 OF 1954, 57 OF 1954 AND 14 OF 1955.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL
CORPORATION OF LIMASSOL.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Law, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol hereby make the following bye-laws : —

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Limassol Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1960, and shall be read as one with the Limassol Municipal Bye-laws, 1953 to 1957 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Limassol Municipal Bye-laws, 1953 to 1960.

2. Bye-law 192 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by substituting for the definition of "salary" therein contained the definition following, i.e.: —

" 'salary' means the annual salary of an officer as approved by the Commissioner under the provisions of the Law, or where no such approval is required, the annual salary of an officer as may be appointed by the Council plus, in each case, any cost-of-living allowance paid to an officer but so that in no case such allowance to exceed twelve and a half per centum of the salary of any such officer ".

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Governor.
