

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 18 (4) of the Water Supply (Municipal and Other Areas) Laws, 1951 and 1952, the Governor hereby sanctions the acquisition of the immovable property under the provisions of the aforesaid Laws.

No. 208. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAWS 26 OF 1952, 43 OF 1955 AND 22 OF 1956.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to Public Instrument No. 68 of 1952 (as amended by Public Instrument No. 362 of 1956) notice is hereby given that easements, privileges and liberties are required to be created and acquired for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein, as follows :—

For the purpose of laying, using and maintaining a water pipeline in, over or under the following privately owned lands, situated in the locality “Laxia tou Papa”, in the village of Kokkini Trimithia, in the District of Nicosia, being plots Nos. 225 and 222 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXI.50 and plots Nos. 12, 13 and 15 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXI.58. The route of the said pipeline is more particularly defined as the line coloured red on the plan marked “Nicosia Airfield Plan ‘E’”, dated the 11th January, 1960, and signed by the Director of Civil Aviation.

All references to easements, privileges and liberties in Public Instrument No. 12 of 1960, and the whole of sub-paragraph (iv) of the first paragraph thereof, are hereby cancelled.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands, who objects to the creation and acquisition of the said easements, privileges and liberties, is required within ten days from the date of the publication of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof and of any claim made by him in respect of such right and interest.

3. The Governor is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said easements, privileges and liberties.

4. The plan mentioned above is available for inspection in my office.

5. The period mentioned in paragraph 2 hereof has been abridged to ten days with the approval of His Excellency the Governor.
