

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 3141

MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Census Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Census (Population and Agriculture) Order, 1960.

2. In this Order—

“ head of household ” means the person by whom information is required to be furnished in accordance with paragraph 5 of this Order ;

“ household ” includes a private household and an institutional household ;

“ institutional household ” means a group of persons living in schools and colleges, penal establishments, hospitals, military installations, hotels, inns, hostels, boarding houses, nursing homes, asylums, monasteries, or other residential institutions, including ships in Cyprus ports ;

“ private household ” means—

(a) a one-person household which is defined as a person who lives alone in a separate housing unit or who, as a lodger, occupies a separate room or rooms in a part of a housing unit but does not join with any of the other occupants to form part of a multi-person household as defined below ;

(b) a multi-person household which is defined to be a group of two or more persons who combine to occupy the whole or part of a housing unit and to provide themselves with food or other essentials for living. The group may pool their incomes and have a common budget to a greater or lesser extent. The group may be composed of related or of unrelated persons or of a combination of both including boarders but excluding lodgers.

3. A census of population and agriculture shall be taken in Cyprus during the night of the 26th/27th November, 1960 (hereinafter referred to as “ the census night ”).

4. Information for the purpose of the census shall be furnished with respect to all persons who shall be alive at midnight on the census night and who pass the night at any place on land or aboard any ship or boat within Cyprus.

5. Information for the purpose of the census with respect to the persons described in paragraph 4, shall be furnished by :—

(a) the head of a private household with respect to all persons who pass the census night in the housing unit under his control ;

(b) the proprietor, manager or other person in charge of an institutional household in respect of all persons who pass the census night in the housing unit or institution under his control.

6. The particulars to be stated on the census forms shall be those set out in the Schedule hereto,
