SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

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**THE ELECTIONS (HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND
COMMUNAL CHAMBERS) LAWS, 1959 AND 1960.**

DECLARATION OF ELECTION OF CANDIDATES UNDER SECTION 17.

Whereas by section 17 of the Elections (House of Representatives and Communal Chambers) Laws, 1959 and 1960, it is, *inter alia*, provided that if on the day of nomination, after the expiration of the time appointed for nomination, and after the disposal of any objections under section 13, the number of candidates standing nominated is equal to or is less than the number of seats to be filled, the Returning Officer shall forthwith declare the nominated candidates to be elected and cause the names of the persons so elected to be published in the *Gazette*.

And whereas on the day of nomination and after the expiration of the time appointed for the nomination and the making of objections, only the candidates whose names appear in the Schedule hereto stood nominated for election as members of the Greek Communal Chamber for the Constituency of Limassol and their number being equal to the number of seats to be filled in the said Constituency of Limassol they were declared by me to be elected :

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 17 (1) of the aforesaid Law, the names of the said persons so elected are hereby published in the *Gazette*.
