The Parliament of Australia enacts:

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Telecommunications (Interception)
Legislation Amendment Act 2000*.

2 Commencement

- (1) Subject to subsection (2), this Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
