# An Act to amend legislation relating to telecommunications, and for other purposes

## 1 Short title [see Note 1]

This Act may be cited as the *Telecommunications Legislation Amendment (Competition and Consumer Safeguards) Act 2010*.

## 2 Commencement

- (1) Each provision of this Act specified in column 1 of the table commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect according to its terms.
