5     **1 Short title**

6                     This Act may be cited as the *Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry*  
7                     *Legislation Amendment (Export Control and Quarantine) Act*  
8                     2006.

9     **2 Commencement**

10                    (1) Each provision of this Act specified in column 1 of the table  
11                    commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with  
12                    column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect  
13                    according to its terms.

10 After “or not”, insert “and whether on land, or in or on water, or not”.
