A BILL

FOR

AN ACT

To amend the Defence Act 1903-1914.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

- 1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Defence Act 1915*. Short title and citation.
- 5 (2.) The *Defence Act 1903-1914* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Defence Act 1903-1915*.
- 10 2. Section seven of the *Defence Act 1914* shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of August One thousand nine hundred and fourteen. Operation of Defence Act 1914, s. 7.
- 3. Section thirty-one of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in sub-section (2.) thereof, after the word "Aviation," the word "Survey,". Amendment of s. 31.
- 15 4.—(1.) Section fifty-five of the Principal Act is amended by inserting, after the words "while on active service," the words "whether within or without the limits of the Commonwealth,". Amendment of s. 55.
- (2.) This section shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of August One thousand nine hundred and fourteen.
