A BILL FOR AN ACT

To impose Liability upon Employees to make Contributions in respect of Insurance against certain Contingencies affecting Employees, and the Wives, Children, Widows, and Orphans of Employees.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *National Health and Pensions Insurance (Employees' Contributions) Act 1938*. Short title.
2. This Act shall commence on a date to be fixed by Proclamation. Commencement
3. The *National Health and Pensions Insurance Act 1938* shall be incorporated and read as one with this Act. Incorporation
4. In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears— Definitions.
 - 10 "insurance" means insurance under the *National Health and Pensions Insurance Act 1938* ;
 - "National Health and Pensions Insurance" means insurance under the *National Health and Pensions Insurance Act 1938* ;
 - "the Schedule" means the Schedule to this Act.
