MISUSE OF DRUGS (SCHEDULED SUBSTANCES) (EXEMPTION) ORDER 1993.

The Minister for Health in exercise of the powers conferred on him by <u>Section 3</u> of the <u>Misuse of Drugs</u> <u>Act, 1977</u> (No. 12 1977) hereby orders as follows:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Scheduled Substances) (Exemption) Order, 1993.
- 2. In this Order:—

"animal remedy" has the same meaning as in the Animal Remedies Act, 1993 (No. 23 of 1993);

"medical preparation" has the same meaning as in <u>Section 65</u> of the <u>Health Act, 1947</u> as amended by <u>Section 39</u> of the <u>Health Act, 1953</u> (No. 26 of 1953) and by <u>Section 7</u> of the <u>Health (Family Planning)</u> (<u>Amendment) Act, 1992</u> (No. 20 of 1992);

3. Sub-section (1) of <u>Section 3</u> of the <u>Misuse of Drugs Act, 1977</u> shall not apply to the controlled drugs specified in the Schedule to this Order provided that such drugs as aforesaid do not contain any other substance, preparation or other product which itself is a controlled drug.

SCHEDULE

1. Any animal remedy or medical preparation containing one or more of the following substances or their salts, namely:—

N-Acetylanthranilic acid

Ephedrine

Ergometrine

Ergotamine

Isosafrole (cis isomer)

Isosafrole (trans isomer)

Lysergic acid

- 3,4-Methylenedioxyphenylpropan-2-One
- 1-Phenyl-2-propanone (otherwise known as phenylacetone)
