HEALTH (ANTIOXIDANT IN FOOD) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1992.

The Minister for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by <u>sections 5</u> and <u>59</u> of the <u>Health Act, 1947</u> (No. 28 of 1947), and section 54 of that Act as amended by the European Communities (<u>Health Act, 1947</u>, Amendment of Sections 54 and 61) Regulations, 1991 (<u>S.I. No. 333 of 1991</u>) and <u>section 38</u> (3) of the <u>Health Act, 1953</u> (No. 26 of 1953) and <u>section 6</u> of the <u>Health Act, 1970</u> (No. 1 of 1970) and, after consultation with the Minister for Industry and Commerce and the Minister for Agriculture and Food, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. (i) These Regulations may be cited as the Health (Antioxidant in Food) (Amendment) Regulations, 1992.
 - (ii) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 22nd day of April, 1992.
- 2. In these Regulations "the Principal Regulations" means the Health (Antioxidant in Food) Regulations, 1973 (S.I. No. 148 of 1973).
- 3. These Regulations and the Health (Antioxidant in Food) Regulations, 1973 (<u>S.I. No. 148 of 1973</u>) as amended by the Health (Antioxidant in Food) (Amendment) Regulations, 1983 (<u>S.I. No. 61 of 1983</u>) shall be construed as one and may be cited together as the Health (Antioxidant in Food) Regulations, 1973 to 1992.
- 4. The Principal Regulations as amended by the Health (Antioxidant in Food) (Amendment) Regulations, 1983 are hereby amended by:—
 - (i) the deletion of article 6 and the substitution therefor of the following article:—

"6. In any proceedings for an offence under these Regulations, it shall be a defence for the person charged to show that the food in respect of which the offence is alleged to have been committed was intended for export and complied with the domestic food legislation of the importing country relevant to the alleged offence."
