1. This Order may be cited as the Civil Contingencies Fund (Increase of Capital) Order, 2007, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st August, 2007, and shall, unless earlier revoked, cease to have effect on the 1st August, 2008.

2. The capital of the Fund shall, during the continuance in force of this Order, be increased to two billion Kenya shillings.
