# THE PUBLIC ORDER (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2019 A Bill for

## AN ACT of Parliament to amend the Public Order Act, and for connected purposes

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Kenya, as follows—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Public Order Short title. (Amendment) Act, 2019.
- 2. The Public Order Act (Cap. 56) is amended in Amendment of section 5 by inserting the following new sub-sections 56. immediately after sub-section (11)—

section 5 of Cap.

- "(11A) A person who while at a public meeting or public procession causes grievous harm, damage to property or loss of earnings, be liable upon conviction shall imprisonment for a term not exceeding six years or to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand shillings, or both.
- (11B) Where a person is convicted of an offence under subsection (11A), the court may an order over and above the sentence imposed, that the person or the organizer compensates the affected persons on such terms as the court may deem proper to grant."
