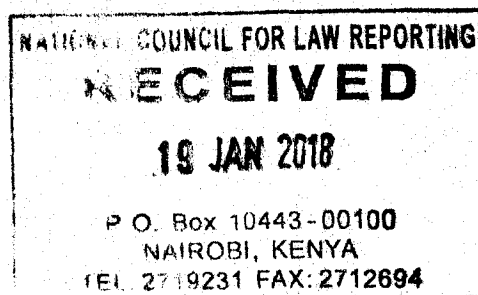

THE COUNTY PENSION SCHEME BILL, 2017**A Bill for**

AN ACT of Parliament to establish the County Pension Scheme; to provide for the management and administration of the scheme; and for connected purposes

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya, as follows—

PART I—PRELIMINARY

1. This Act may be cited as the County Pension Scheme Act, 2017. Short title.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires— Interpretation.

“actuary” has the meaning assigned to it in section 2 of the Retirement Benefits Act; No. 3 of 1997.

“annuity” means a pension purchased under a contract with a Registered Insurer;

“approved issuer” means an Approved Issuer appointed by the Board to provide the services of an Approved Issuer as defined in the Retirement Benefits Act; No. 3 of 1997.

“associated organization” means any person, firm, company, county agency or county corporation or organization of employees or association of employers created by, owned by or associated with county governments, urban areas and cities or other institution, established under the County Governments Act, Urban Areas and Cities Act, or their staff or any other person or body providing services to county governments or to their employees and includes those organizations whether associated with county governments or not that choose to participate in the Scheme by signing a deed of adherence; No. 17 of 2012.
No. 13 of 2011.

“Auditor” means the Auditor-General appointed under Article 229 of the Constitution;

“Authority” means the Retirement Benefits Authority;

“Board” means the Board of Trustees established under section 6;

“Cabinet Secretary” means the Cabinet Secretary responsible for Public Service;
