ANIMALS ACT 1982 ANIMALS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2008

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 18 and 20 of the Animals Act 1982 and all other powers in this regard, Cabinet hereby makes the following regulations-

1. SHORT TITLE

These Regulations may be cited as the Animals (Amendment) Regulations 2008.

2. INTERPRETATION

In this Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires-

"the Act" means the Animals Act 1982;

3. PURPOSE

The purpose of these Regulations is to amend the Animals Regulations 2000 to remove the requirement for an import licence for live animals.

4. AMENDMENT OF ANIMALS REGULATIONS 2000

- (1) Regulation 3. of the Animals Regulations 2000 is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:
- "3. The application of Section 11 of the Act is hereby extended to all animals."
- (2) Regulation 4. of the Animals Regulations 2000 and the Schedule to the Animals Regulations 2000 are hereby repealed and replaced with the following:
- "4. Pursuant to Section 4(2) of the Act, the fee payable for a licence for keeping a dog is \$50.00."

AGRICULTURAL QUARANTINE ACT 1999 AGRICULTURAL QUARANTINE (ANIMALS IMPORT) REGULATIONS 2008

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 38 of the Agricultural Quarantine Act 1999 and all other powers in this regard, Cabinet hereby makes the following regulations-

1. SHORT TITLE

These Regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Quarantine (Animal Import) Regulations 2008

2. INTERPRETATION

In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires-

"the Act" means the Agricultural Quarantine Act 1999;

"Import Permit" means an Animal Quarantine Entry Permit as defined Under Regulations 4 and 19 of the Plant and Animal Quarantine Regulations 2004;

"Regulation" where used in Schedule 1 means the Plants and Animals Quarantine Regulations 2004.

3. PURPOSE

The purpose of these Regulations is to amend the Plant and Animal Quarantine Regulations 2004 to remove from schedule 4, the fees payable for an Import Permit for live animals, and to make new provision for lower fees in respect of Import Permits for live animals under these regulations.

4. AMENDMENT OF PLANTS AND ANIMALS QUARANTINE REGULATIONS 2004

Paragraph (2) (i) of Schedule 4 to the Plants and Animals Quarantine Regulations 2004 is hereby repealed.

5. FEES

The fees payable in respect of an Import Permit shall be the fees set out in Schedule 1.
