## PUBLIC SERVICE ACT 1961-1971

## SECTION 27 (2) NAURUAN BASIC WAGE

It is notified for general information that His Excellency President Hammer DeRoburt, O.B.E. M.P., has under Section 27 Sub-Section 2 of the Public Service Act 1961-1971 determined that the Nauruan Basic Wage should be varied in accordance with the movement in the Cost of Living Index on Nauru for the period November, 1972 to 15th May, 1974.

In consequence of the above, the Nauruan Basic Wage for male adults has been adjusted as follows and applicable in the Public Service of Naurua

RATE

DATE EFFECTIVE

\$1,743.00 per annum \$1,961.00 per annum

15th May, 1973 15th November, 1973

\$2,290.00 per annum

15th May, 1974

The rate for adult females shall be 75% of the Nauruan Basic Wage for male adults. Those under the age of twenty one years shall be paid at the existing rate for age.
