Against determination of the Nauru Lands Committee published in Gazette No. 5 of 1973 concerning an area of phosphate land on the border of Anibare and Uaboe Districts comprising eight portions, namely,

2. Ijuwokoe, portion no. 334;
3. Ijuwokoe, portion no. 231;
4. Atabio, portion no. 338;
5. Atabio, portion no. 339;
6. Idonga, portion no. 340;
7. Ijuwokoe, portion no. 230;
8. Ijuwokoe, portion no. 336;

Judgement. The 9th day of August, 1973.

Mr. Justice I. R. Thompson, Chief Justice.

Appeals Nos. 5, 7 and 12 dismissed.

Appeals Nos. 10 and 14 allowed to the extent as follows:

10. Mockin now portion 341 owned by Eibaoeda Scotty and the persons named in Gazette No. 52 of 1973 as joint owners with her, or their successors.
(The identity of the successors, if any persons has died, has not been established in these proceedings.)

The boundaries of these portions and their respective sizes are unascertainable. The whole of the land to be divided into 10 equal portions with out regard for the position of walls. The portion Mockin to adjoin Heinrich's portion (No. 126) of that same name;

the portions Atabio to adjoin one another and be located adjacent to the portions of that name to the south and east of the land in issue; as far as possible

portions named Ijuwokoe to adjoin one another and to be located adjacent to the portion of that name, No. 229, to the north of the land in issue, as far as possible;

the two portions named Idonga are to adjoin one another.

Determinations published in Gazette No. 5 of 1973 relating to the eight portions set aside and ordered that the re-apportionment be as set out above.

Directed. Plan showing division of the land into ten equal portions be prepared by the Director of Lands and Surveys and submitted to the Registrar for approval. The allocation of individual portions within groups of portions of the same name is then to be made by the Registrar drawing lots in the presence of the Director of Lands and Surveys and a member of the Nauru Lands Committee (other than Mr. Agoko). The details are then to be published in the Gazette.

AND WHEREAS on the 30th August, 1973 the plan required by the above judgement was submitted to and approved by the Registrar of the Supreme Court (see page 9 for plan).

AND WHEREAS on the 30th August, 1973 the allocation of individual portions within groups of portions of the same name was made by the Registrar of the Supreme Court by drawing lots in the presence of the Director of Lands and Surveys and a member of the Nauru Lands Committee and the details of the drawing of lots were as follows:-
