An Act to make provision regarding the observance of Anzac Day

1 Short Title

This Act may be cited as the Anzac Day Act 1966.

2 Anzac Day to be a day of commemoration

- (1) In commemoration of the part taken by New Zealand servicemen and servicewomen in—
 - (a) the First and Second World Wars; and
 - (b) the South African War; and
 - (c) the Korean War; and
 - (d) the war in Malaya/Borneo; and
 - (e) the war in South Vietnam—

and in memory of those who at any time have given their lives for New Zealand and the British Empire or Commonwealth of Nations, 25 April in each year (being the anniversary of the first landing of troops from the United Kingdom, Australia, and New Zealand on Gallipoli) shall be known as Anzac Day, and shall be a day of commemoration.

- (2) The Governor-General may from time to time, by Order in Council, amend subsection (1) by adding to the list of conflicts referred to in that subsection.
- (3) An order under this section is secondary legislation (*see* Part 3 of the Legislation Act 2019 for publication requirements).

3 Observance of Anzac Day

- (1) Where Anzac Day falls on a Sunday it shall be observed as a Sunday.
- (2) Where Anzac Day does not fall on a Sunday, it shall be observed up to 1 o'clock in the afternoon as if it were a Sunday, and after that hour on that day such activities shall be permitted as may lawfully take place after noon on a Saturday.
