RPPL No. 9–18 Passed as House Bill No. 9-1-1, HD2, SD2, PD1

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend the provisions in Chapter 12 of Title 40 of the Palau National Code relating to the gross revenue tax, to amend the Road Use Tax, and for other purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF PALAU REPRESENTED IN THE OLBIIL ERA KELULAU DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Legislative Findings</u>. The Olbiil Era Kelulau finds that with the enactment of the recent minimum wage law, and with the continued requirement that employers contribute 2.5% toward the Palau National Health Insurance, the private sector needs an additional economic stimulant so that it will continue to grow. This bill will provide a tax break to companies; before they calculate gross revenue to be taxed, the entire salary or wages paid to Palauan citizens is deducted from amount of the gross revenue, and up to \$5,000 in salary or wages paid to foreign workers. The Olbiil Era Kelulau finds that this tax break will counter the effects of the minimum wage law on small business that are hard-pressed to meet the new requirements.

Section 2. <u>Amendment</u>. 40 PNC § 1404, as amended by RPPL No. 9-10, is
hereby amended to read as follows:

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"§ 1404. Road use tax.

. . .

(a) There is hereby assessed and levied an annual road use tax on all motor
vehicles, including vehicles owned by all agencies of the National Government, state
governments and state agencies, and public corporations. All agencies and public
corporations that may be exempt from taxes under other laws of the Republic shall pay
the road use tax. The road use tax shall be payable at the time required for
registration of each vehicle to be assessed the road use tax as follows:

20 (3) All motor vehicles weighing between four thousand (4,000) pounds
21 and six thousand (6,000) pounds-- one hundred fifty dollars (\$150). Any person
22 who paid a two hundred dollar (\$200) road use tax in accordance with RPPL
23 No. 9-10 shall receive a credit of fifty dollars (\$50) towards their future road use
