FOURTH OLBIIL ERA KELULAU

RPPL NO. 4 -16

First Regular Session, January 1993 (Intro. as SB 4-54, SDI, HD4)

AN ACT

To require that each person's identification card number and driver's license number be the same as his Social Security Number, to raise fees for licenses and identification cards, and for other purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF PALAU REPRESENTED IN THE OLBIIL ERA KELULAU DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Identical numbers. The Minister of Justice shall, within one year of the effective date of this Act, coordinate and implement a program whereby each person's identification card number and motor vehicle operator's license number shall bear the same number as an individual's Social Security Number.

Section 2. Amendments. 34 PNC 4102 and 4103 are hereby amended as follows:

"§4102. Identification card; description. All identification cards issued pursuant to this Chapter shall be encased in plastic, and shall contain the following information for each person to whom a card is issued:

(a) Legal name;

....

(c) Date and Place of birth, Citizenship;

....

(m) Identification card number which is identical to Social Security Number. "

"§4103. Procedure for issuance.

(a) Identification cards may be obtained by any resident of the Republic who is 16 years of age or over. Such cards may be obtained from the Office of the Bureau of Public Safety upon payment of a fee of \$5.00 and submission of the information required to be contained on the card. " Section 3.

Amendments. 42 PNC 401, 405, and 406 are hereby amended as follows:

"§401. Required: fees; breadth or privilege granted by license. No person except those expressly exempted in this Chapter. . . . A fee of \$10.00 shall be paid to the Director for each such license issued. All such fees . . . "

"§405. Learner's permits and fees.

....

(d) A fee of \$10.00 shall be paid to the Director for each permit issued. All such fees shall be deposited
... "
