AN ACT

To amend RPPL No. 1-37 to restore hazardous duty differential for employees of the Bureau of Public Safety.

THE PEOPLE OF PALAU REPRESENTED IN THE OLBIIL ERA KELULAU DO ENACT AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 9(4)(d) of RPPL No. 1-37 is amended by the addition of Subparagraph (iv) to read as follows:

“(iv) Police hazardous duty differential. Employees of the police force of the Bureau of Public Safety, Ministry of Justice, shall be eligible to receive a special hazardous duty differential of up to twenty five percent of their adjusted base salaries. The Director of the Bureau of Public Safety shall promulgate rules and regulations governing the specific eligibility criteria for employees of the police force to receive this differential”.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the President of the Republic of Palau, or upon its becoming law without such approval, except as otherwise provided by law.
