## [ PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1307, March 02, 1978 ]

## FURTHER AMENDING PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1183, AS AMENDED BY PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1205

**WHEREAS,** it is the policy of the Government to ease the restrictions on foreign travel;

**WHEREAS,** in furtherance thereof, it is deemed necessary to expand further the coverage of the provision exempting certain persons from the payment of the travel tax;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS,** President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers in me vested by the Constitution do hereby order and decree the following:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2 of P. D. No. 1183 as amended by section 2 of P. D. 1205 is hereby further amended by adding a new paragraph after paragraph "I" thereof which shall read as follows:

"m) Persons whose travel is provided or funded by foreign governments with which the Philippine Government maintains diplomatic relations."

**SECTION 2.** All acts, decrees, executive orders, administrative orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with the provision of this Decree are repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 3.** This Decree shall take effect immediately.
