[PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 920, April 05, 1976]

AMENDING SECTION 1 OF PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 897 FIXING MINIMUM PRICES OF LOCALLY GROWN VIRGINIA LEAF TOBACCO, TO PROVIDE FOR NEW MINIMUM PRICES THEREOF.

WHEREAS, after further studies, it has been established at the existing minimum prices of locally produced Virginia leaf tobacco as set forth in Presidential Decree No. 897 are by present standards still inadequate, considering the high cost of production;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Constitution, do hereby decree and order as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Presidential Decree No. 897 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"**SEC. 1**. Beginning with the tobacco trading year 1976, no person, corporation, partnership or association shall buy locally grown Virginia loaf tobacco at prices lower than the following:

GRADE A	P8.00 per
	kilogram
GRADE B	7.50 per
	kilogram
GRADE C	7.00 per
	kilogram
GRADE D	6.50 per
	kilogram
GRADE E	6.00 per
	kilogram

The description of each grade shall be determined by the Philippine Virginia Tobacco Administration.

SEC. 2. This Decree shall take effect immediately.
