[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8836, August 22, 2000]

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY CAMANTANG, MUNICIPALITY OF CAN-AVID, PROVINCE OF EASTERN SAMAR, TO BE KNOWN AS THE CAMANTANG NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING **FUNDS THEREFOR**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There shall be established a national high school in Barangay Camantang, Municipality of Can-avid, Province of Eastern Samar to be known as the Camantang National High School.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports shall promulgate and issue such rules and regulations as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this Act.

SEC. 3. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be included in the General Appropriations Act of the year following its enactment into law and thereafter.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
